

MAURIZIO MORETTA



Maurizio Moretta was born in Gravedona (CO) he did piano studies at the "V.Appiani" Liceo Musicale in Monza under the guidance of Prof. Losi and M ° Centemeri, graduating in 1988 at the "G.Verdi" Conservatory of Milan with honors. He perfected in Milan with V. Balzani and in Munich under the guidance of L. Hoffmann. After winning the First Prize at the "Viotti" International Piano Competition in Varallo, he started an intense concert activity that sees him as a guest in the most important Italian cities and abroad in locations such as the Teatro Manzoni and Sala Verdi in Milan, Teatro Comunale di Savona, Palazzo Barberini and Cloister of Bramante in Rome. He has been invited as a soloist several times. to collaborate with the Symphony Orchestras of: Bacau, Satu-Mare and Oradea (Romania); Vidin (Bulgaria); P. Tchaikovsky (Russia); the Cameristi del Verbano, City of Grosseto, Regional of Friuli Venezia Giulia and Magna Grecia (Italy). He was invited to Rome, from the Embassies of Italy and Russia, for the performance of the first concert for piano and orchestra of Tchaikovsky performed last year also in the renowned "Smetana Hall" in Prague, with the North Czech Philahrmony Teplice. Last year he was invited to the prestigious Musikverein in Vienna as a soloist with the Wiener Mozart Orchestra. Director of the Civic "Alto Lario" Music Institute (CO); on behalf of the Councilor for Tourism of the Province of Como, he has edited the Sinfolario Festival and Lario Jazz and R'n'B Festival.
